

THE MASTER BREEDER

The Judging Board has established an elite category of IFGA breeders called “master-breeder”. This achievement is difficult to attain and should be held in the highest regard. To be initially eligible, a breeder must be active in both breeding and exhibiting in IFGA shows. The following criteria are established:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Points</u>	<u>Minimum Points</u>
GMO Placement (Top Ten)	1	3
GFO Placement (Top Ten)	¼	0
BOS Delta or Tank	1	5
BOS Veil/Sword	¼	0
Class Championships	1	3
Female Class Championships	¼	0
Service to IFGA	¼	½

Individuals seeking recognition as a “master breeder” must apply to the Judging Board, listing his/her qualifications and secure board approval. An applicant must have at least 15 points, as well as the minimum points in the above categories. No substitutions will be allowed. The Judging Board will maintain the list of all current master breeders and once awarded, the designation is permanent.
